"Our camp is open to all youth, as many of our campers are friends or siblings of youth with challenging abilities," said Cage. "During the time the kids are here they are given opportunities to participate in the same kind of activities that kids all over the world have done for years. We are here to focus on what is possible rather than impossible," said Cage.
