The camp has been struggling financially as a non-profit organization for the past few years in this economy. After our Summer season 2010 numerous emergency meetings were held to come up with ideas and money to save the camp. The Lions Foundation of Florida stepped in and took over the deed, keeping the camp running until December to give the board time to try and raise the money. Unfortunately the board was not able to find a solution and as of January 1<sup>st</sup> the camp is on the market to be sold.

We will be hosting a "Farewell FLC" party on January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2011 from 1pm-4pm at the camp in the blue room. This will be a chance for our campers to say farewell to FLC as well as a chance for our staff to say farewell to you. Lions of Florida will also be invited to find out how they can help our campers with this transition. Snacks and refreshments will be served. You may bring any pictures or memories to share. Please RSVP to me by January 26<sup>th</sup> to let me know if you are attending and how many people will be joining you. Don't forget to wear your favorite FLC shirt!

We are referring our campers to Camp Thunderbird in Apopka, FL. They offer a very similar program to FLC's. Many of FLC's supporters are working with Camp Thunderbird to help prepare them for our campers. Although, they may not be prepared to accommodate all of our campers by next summer, they are working diligently to become more inclusive. Many of you may even recognize their current Camp Director, Rob Cage as our past Camp Director here at FLC. He is willing to try and work with everyone to get your needs met.
